The change in footfall for Southbourne Town Centre over the last 52 weeks is 0.2% down on the previous year.

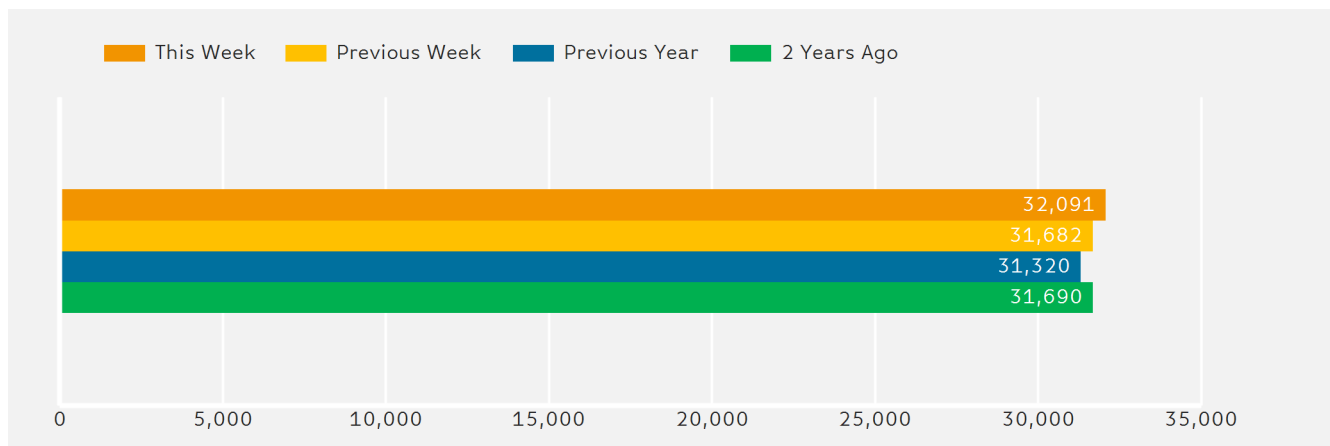
Footfall for the year to date is 0.9% down on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 14 May 2018 was 32,091.

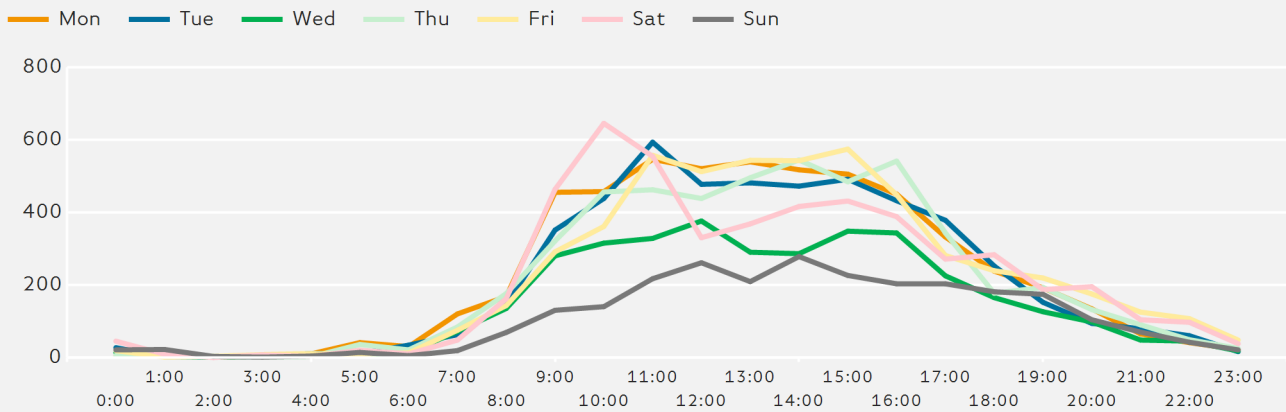
The busiest day in week commencing 14 May 2018 was Monday with 5,397 visitors.

Footfall by Week



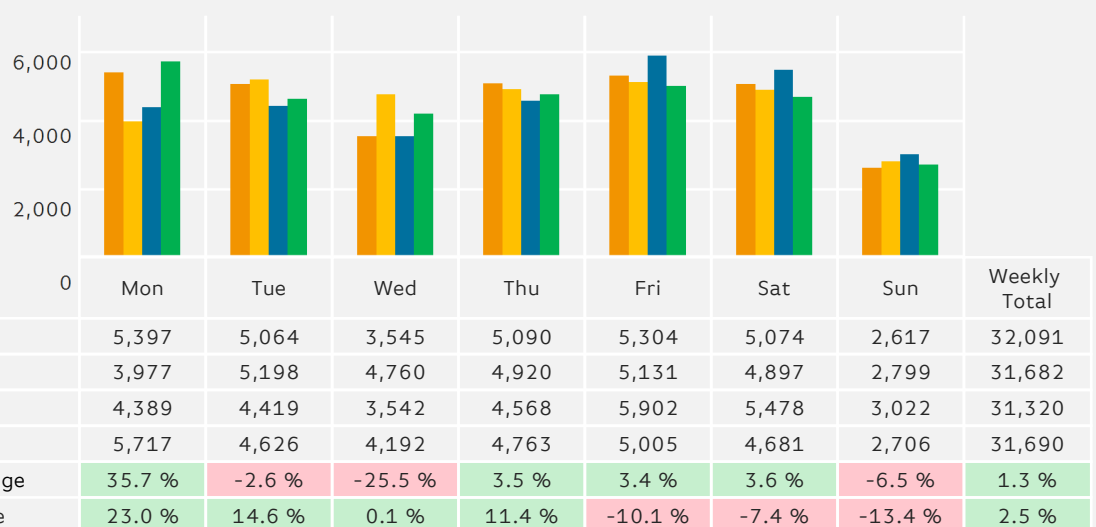
Footfall by Hour

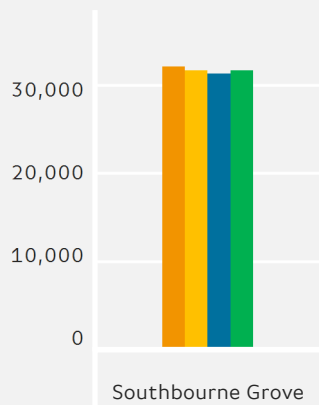

Footfall by Day



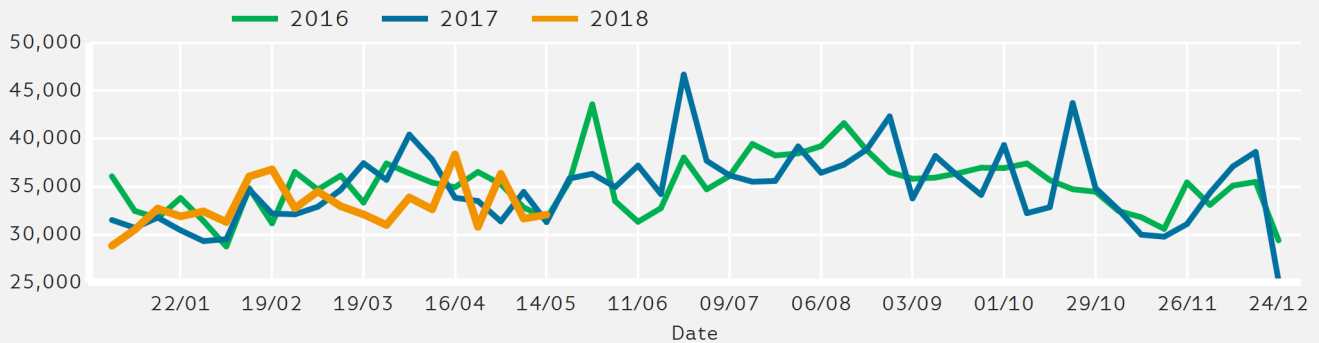
