Cycling

Hiring a bike is a great way to explore the seven miles of golden sands along the seafront – you can even venture into Poole and out to the Sandbanks Peninsular and have a nose around one of the most expensive places to live in the UK. Or, head east and cycle out to Hengistbury Head. The prom is level, mostly traffic free and gives great views across to Old Harry and the Jurassic Coast, or the Needles and the Isle of Wight. 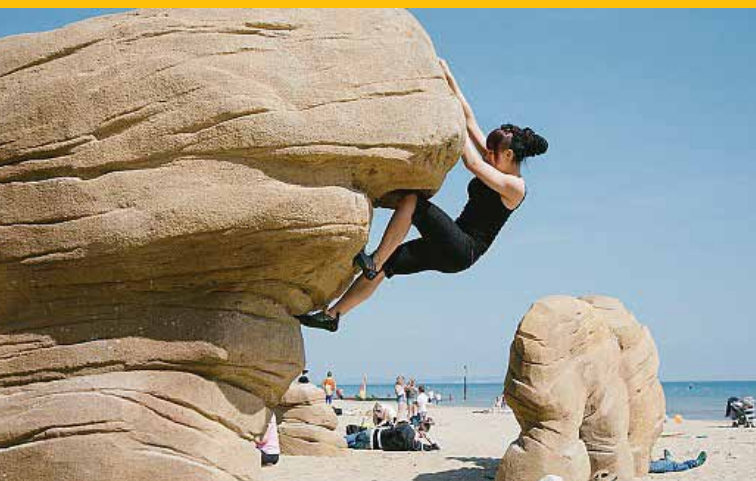

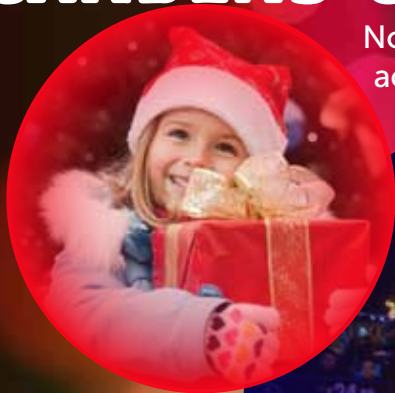
