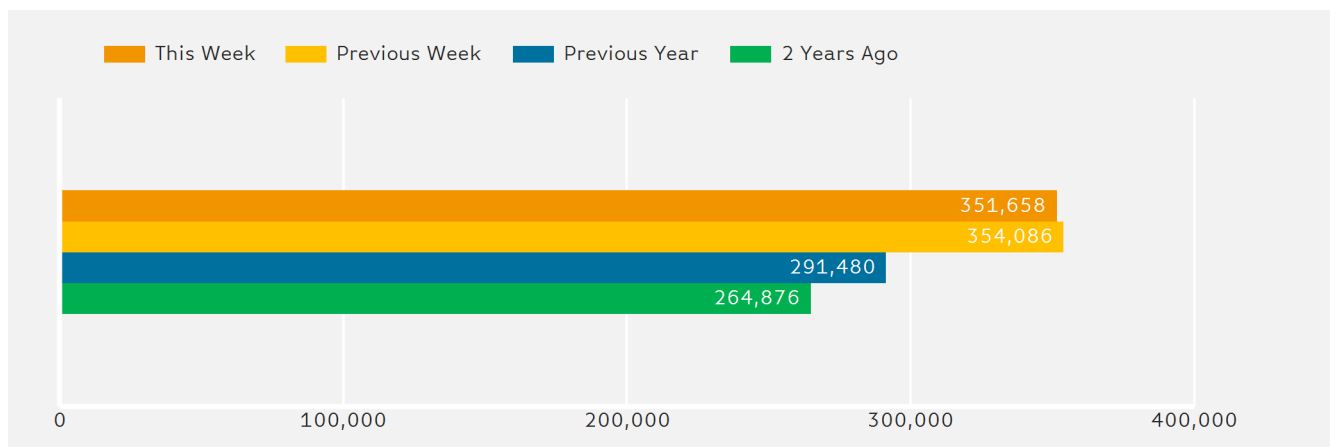
The change in footfall for Bournemouth over the last 52 weeks is 4.7% up on the previous year.

Footfall for the year to date is 6% up on the previous year.

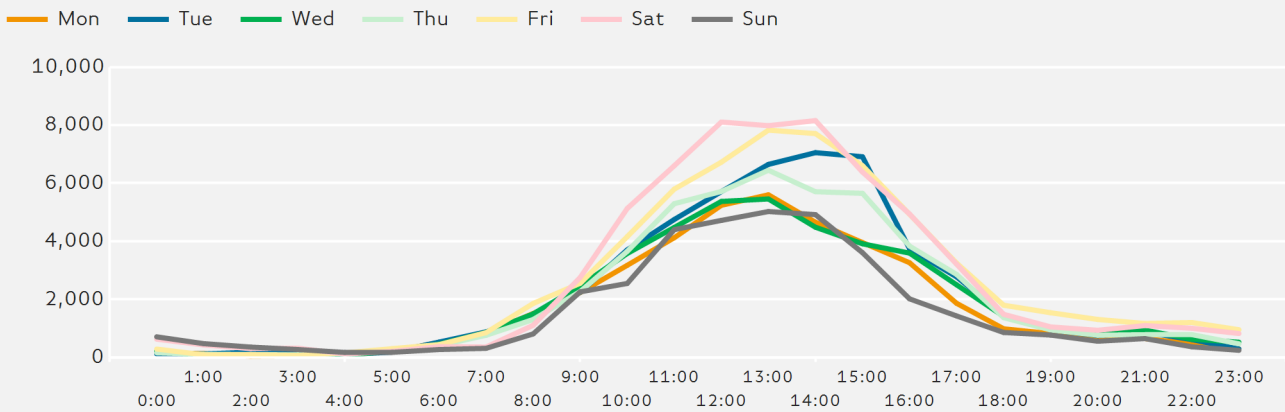
The number of visitors counted for week commencing 12 March 2018 was 351,658.

The busiest day in week commencing 12 March 2018 was Saturday with 63,546 visitors.

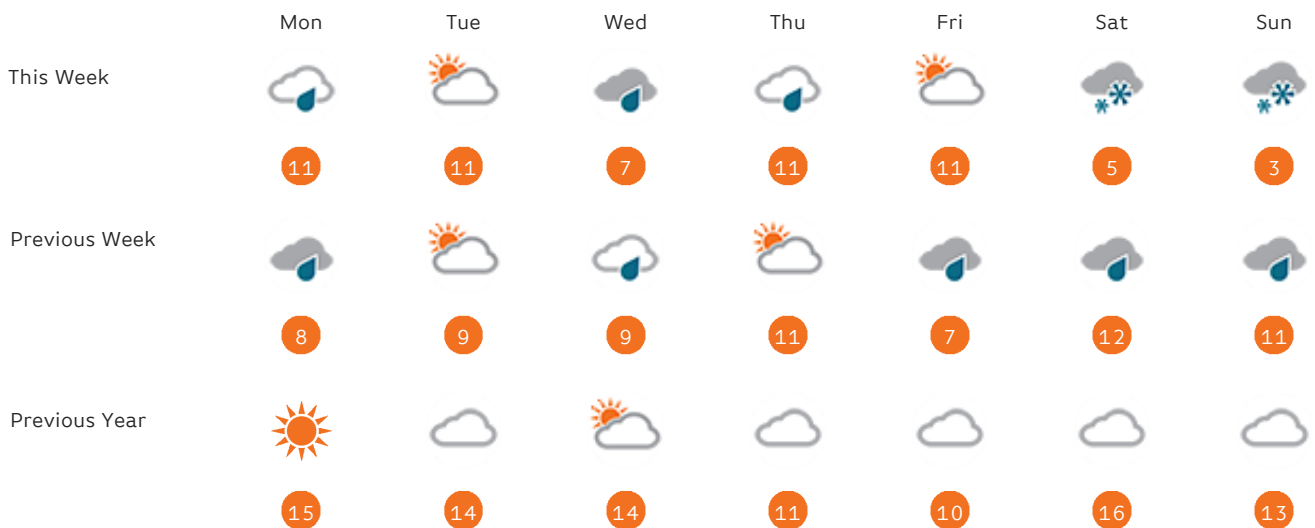
The peak hour of the week was 14:00 on Saturday with footfall of 8,157

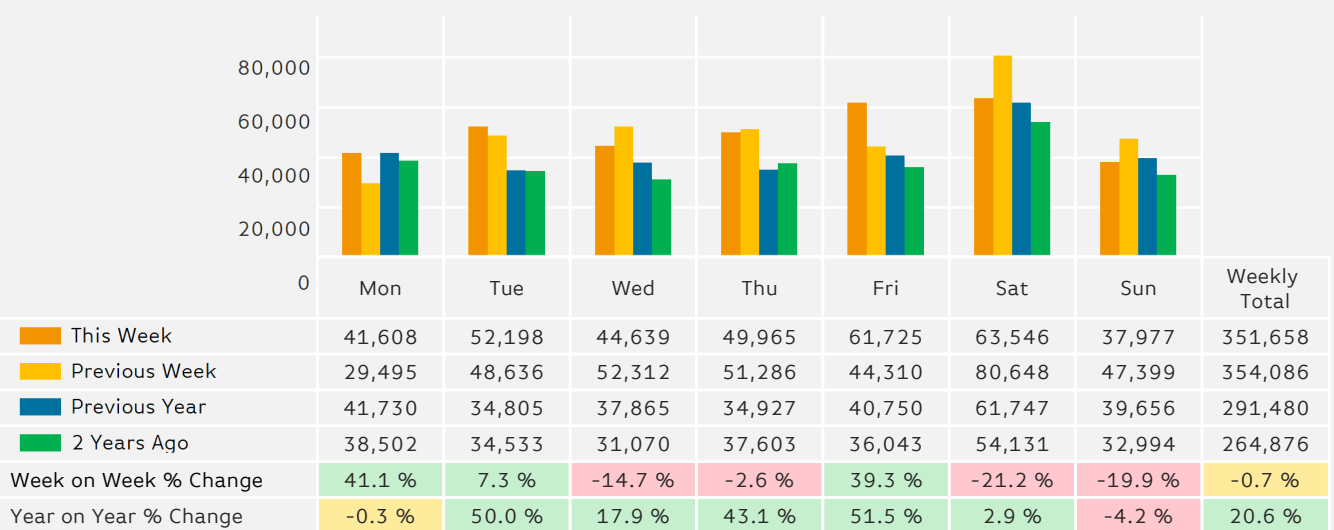
Footfall by Hour

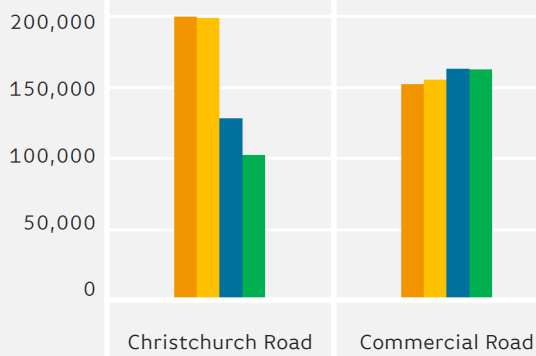


Footfall by Day



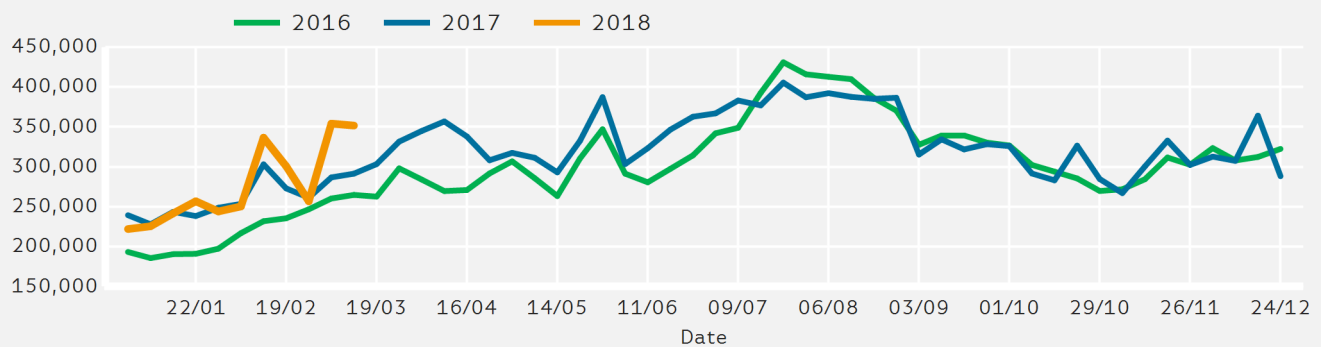
