The change in footfall for Westbourne Town Centre over the last 52 weeks is 1.8% up on the previous year.


Footfall for the year to date is 1.4% down on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 2 April 2018 was 35,097.


The busiest day in week commencing 2 April 2018 was Thursday with 7,269 visitors.

Footfall by Week




Footfall by Hour


